

Installing Synchting as a service in Ubuntu

Installing Synchting and then adding it as a service in Ubuntu:

1. Add the Synchting APT repository key:

```
curl -s https://synchting.net/release-key.txt | gpg --dearmor | sudo tee /etc/apt/trusted.gpg.d/synchting.gpg > /dev/null
```

2. Add the Synchting APT repository:

```
echo "deb https://apt.synchting.net/ synchting stable" | sudo tee /etc/apt/sources.list.d/synchting.list
```

3. Update your package database:

```
sudo apt update
```

4. Install Synchting:

```
sudo apt install synchting
```

5. Start Synchting:

```
synchting
```

Alternatively, you can set up Synchting to run as a service:

```
sudo systemctl enable synchting@$USER.service
```

```
sudo systemctl start synchting@$USER.service
```

These steps should help you install and start Synchting on your Ubuntu system.
